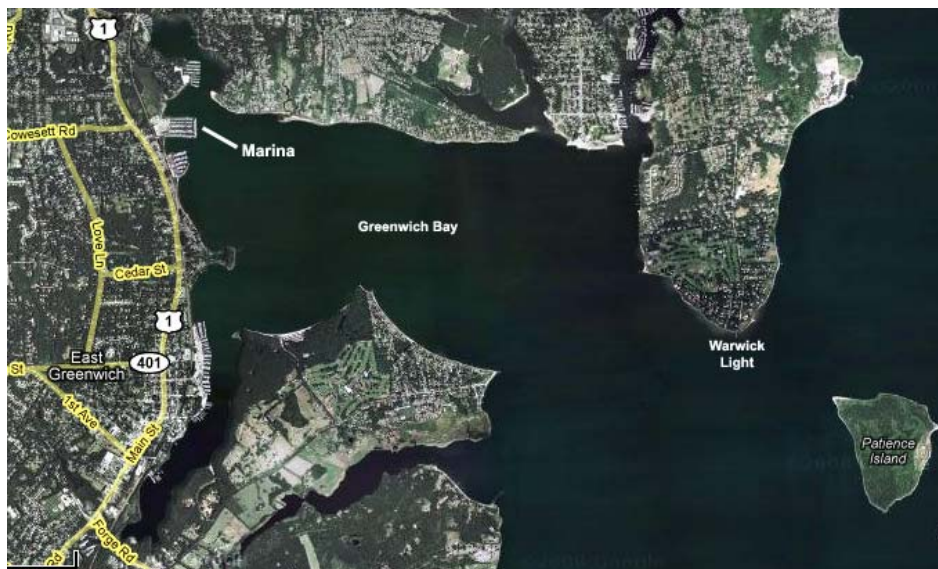


# DIRECTIONS BY BOAT



- Brewer Greenwich Bay marina is located on the northwestern shore of Greenwich Bay at Apponaug Cove green can #3 (see chart)

- As you approach the marina, contact the “Saltwater Anglers Dockmaster” on channel 65 for docking help.

- If many are calling in at the same time, please be patient.

- The marina has Docks A through F, and on each dock there is a north and south. For example, you may be told to go to Dock “D South”



## NEARBY BOAT RAMPS

1. ALLENS HARBOR RAMP (\$10 fee, \$5 in N.K. resident)

2. CROMPTON AVE. TOWN RAMP (free)

East Greenwich (low water)

3. PONAUG MARINA RAMP (\$8 fee)

I-95 to exit 10A. Go EAST on Route 117. This is Centerville Road. To 3rd light (approximately 1 mile), and turn right onto Post Road (Route 1) south. Take first left onto Arnolds Neck Dr. Ramp located at Ray’s Bait.

4. OAKLAND BEACH LAUNCH RAMP (DEM Ramp - free)

**Recommended best to use.**

I-95 to exit 10A. Go EAST on Route 117. This is Centerville Road. Just after 3rd light (approximately 1 mile), Route 117 becomes West Shore Road. Stay on West Shore Road (Rt 117) for 3.1 miles and turn right onto Oakland Beach Avenue. Go one mile and turn left onto Suburban Parkway. Go short distance to end, turning right onto Bay Avenue. This takes you to the launch ramp.

5. Wharf Marina (\$10, but donates free to TAK participants)
