and everyone (approximately 70 boats) will fish in Greenwich Bay. At this time of year, Greenwich Bay is loaded with bluefish which are fun to catch. Volunteer members of the R.I. Saltwater Anglers Association will be on every boat to help kids with the fishing - a minimum of two adults per boat. At noon everyone will be treated to a cookout of hamburgers, hot dogs and snacks.
