- Awards for Special Tournaments are presented in each category as follows:

- Boat Division: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place
- Shore Division: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place

• The minimum sizes for all Special Tournament species shall be the current Rhode Island recreational minimums.
