
# Chunking For Striped Bass

featuring

## Charley Soares

"The first and most successful chunkers were the Captains of Industry who founded the Bass Clubs in the mid-1860's," said Charley. "Only they had a chummer they hired for the princely sum of 50 cents a day to do their cutting and spooning out chum for them."

Chunking was one of the first and most successful methods of



attracting and catching large stripers and much of this was pioneered along the Rhode Island coast by some of the wealthiest men in

the world at that time.

Charley has some great illustrations and old photos from that era that he will add into his presentation.



Charley been a full-time guide and journalist for the past 50 years having sold the very first story he ever submitted to Frank Woolner of *Saltwater Sportsman* in 1964. He was a very generous and helpful editor.

He has been a field editor for the Fisherman Group since 1976 and a weekly newspaper columnist for over 40 years.

Charley has been - and is currently - a feature writer for *On The Water* magazine since its inception. He's also a regular contributor to the *Surfcaster's Journal*.

Charley has six books to his credit and several others he has co-written and contributed to.

"If it's possible I enjoy fishing more today than I did when I first began," he said, "and if my son, grandson or a youngster is aboard it makes the trip that much more interesting."
